Grants awarded

The Financial Advice and Problem Solving Grant - £50k per year for the next 3 years. This funding is specifically to contribute to the delivery of a financial advice and problem solving service for the whole borough and its residents.

Main Grants Pot - VCS groups can bid for funding from £500 up to £10,000 to help with their core costs or to support them to deliver great community projects and activities. This year the Council ringfenced £10,000 of this funding to create a separate 'Mental Health and Wellbeing' pot for projects specifically related to Suicide Prevention. VCS groups could bid for between £500 to £5k to help them deliver specific projects around suicide prevention. However, on this occasion due to the limited number of applications received for this pot, the Panel unanimously agreed to return the £10,000 to the Main Grants Pot.

The Main Grants Pot has been broken down into two categories – Lower – grants between £500 and £2,000 and Higher – grants over £2,000 and up to £10,000.
