Fare Increase

From the 1st April Dial A Ride journeys for all customers with a concessionary bus pass will be increased to £5.00 per single journey (and £6.00 for medical journeys).

Customers travelling without a concessionary bus pass will be increased to £6.00 per single journey (and £7.00 for medical journeys).

We will be reducing the registration fee from £16.50 to £15.00 (for Dial A Ride and Shopmobility customers this will reduce to £11 per service).

The Council values this service and this is a way to ensure we can continue to operate – we have had to review the charges considering funding reductions, increases in fuel costs and maintenance of the buses - we hope our customers understand the reasons behind this difficult position.

Charge Increase

From the 1st April our charges to use Shopmobility will be increasing. The Council values this service and this is a way to ensure we can continue to operate - we have had to review the charges considering funding reductions, increases in utility costs and maintenance of the equipment – we hope our customers understand the reasons behind this difficult position.



The daily charge for a registered Redditch

resident to hire a scooter will increase to £4.70 and for a registered non-Redditch resident £6.25. For those customers who are not registered the charge will increase to £7.80. We will be reducing the registration fee from £16.50 to £15.00 (for Dial A Ride and Shopmobility customers this will reduce to £11 per service).
