## Redditch Borough Council - Community Survey 2022

This survey was opened on Friday 14 October 2022; an invite was sent directly to all members of the Community Panel. The survey remained open for 4 full weeks. A total of 137 valid surveys were returned, resulting in a response rate of 32%. The survey was publicised in local media and numerous times on social media during the 4 weeks. A total of 390 surveys were received from the general public resulting in a final figure of 527 valid surveys for analysis.

Some results may appear significantly different when compared with previous years. Whilst this might be a true reflection, it needs to be borne in mind that since 23 March 2020 there have been significant changes to peoples' lives due to the Covid-19 pandemic.
