Riders everywhere should proceed with courtesy, care and consideration.

Care for the Land

Do not stray from the line of the path. Do not damage fences or hedgerows by jumping. Remember that horses' hooves can damage surfaces in wet weather. Pay particular attention to protected areas that have historical or conservation significance and may be extremely sensitive to damage.

Courtesy to other users

Remember that walkers, cyclists and other riders may be elderly, disabled, children or simply frightened of horses; whenever possible acknowledge courtesy shown by other users.

Consideration for the park

1. Shut gates behind you where you found them shut.
2. Ride slowly past all stock. Do not ride on cultivated land unless the right of way crosses it.
3. Observe local bylaws. These are usually on display as you enter the site if applicable.
4. Ride or drive with care on the roads and take the BHS Riding and Road Safety Test. Always make sure that you can be seen by wearing the right kind of reflective/or fluorescent aids.
5. Groups from riding establishments should contain reasonable numbers, for reasons of both safety and amenity, including the relevant number of escorts.

6. Riders should not deviate from the right of way or permitted route and regard must be shown at all time for shutting and securing of gates and the consideration and courtesy due to others.
7. Always obey the Countryside Code: Enjoy the countryside and respect its life and work. Leave gates as you find them. Keep your dogs under close control. Keep to public paths across the park. Use gates and stiles to cross fences, hedges and walls if necessary.

Some key points to consider:

- Take personal responsibility for your own actions.
- Ride safely.
- Care for our environment.
- Take your litter home or use a bin provided.
- Keep your dog(s) under proper control.
- Take extra care around pedestrians and cyclists.


